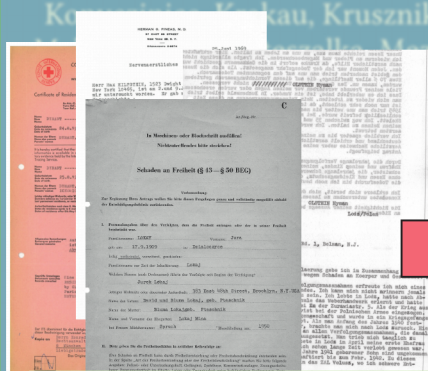


# Evaluating and Publishing Files on Compensation Cases

## The Documents



affidavits, expert opinions, forms, certificates ...



## Data contained

- **Biographical data:** Name, date and place of birth, education, fate during persecution (ghettos, camps, in hiding, escape to USSR), type of damage (**mostly health, freedom, life, education, property**), date of liberation, stay in Germany until emigration (Displaced Person Camps), emigration destination, fate of relatives
- **Affidavits** from applicants and witnesses/**expert opinions describing the persecution** in varying depth

## Developments

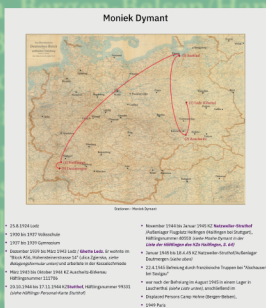
- **Initially no idea** of the content of the files/proceeding/law
- **Initial target:** create **one data record** per applicant, no specifications of data to be stored
- **New targets** with increasing familiarity: **make content/existence of files known, publish examples, show sources**
- with better knowledge: data sets were enhanced, **older data sets had to be updated**

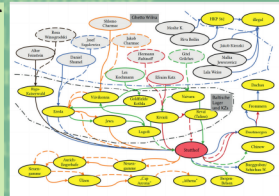

## External Sources for Claimant related biographical Data

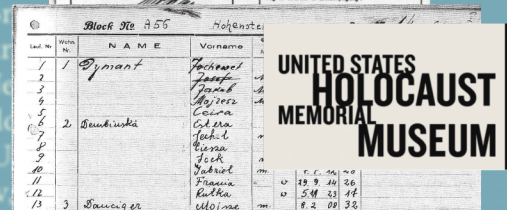
### Online Sources

- documents related to claimant from Arolsen Archives

- Yad Vashem deportation database, see Hermann Pineas' mother Therese
- Wilna/Karl Plagge: search for major plagge
- Leo-Baeck-Institute, see story of Herman Pineas
- the Auschwitz Trials, see Boris Piekny
